



International Articulation Agreement

Between

**TKU College of Business and Management,
Tamkang University,
Taiwan, Republic of China**

And

**QUT Business School,
Queensland University of Technology,
Australia**

Section 1. Context.

The college of Business and Management at Tamkang University (hereafter referred to as TKU) and the QUT Business School at Queensland University of Technology (hereafter referred to as QUTBS) have agreed to enter into a managed articulation agreement based on mutual understanding as indicated below. Although this Agreement is not intended to have legal binding it does indicate the agreed intentions of both parties and the processes they will employ to achieve their goals.

Section 2. Purpose

The parties agree to collaborate in order to achieve the following goals.

- Increase the options for international studies for students at TKU.
- Maximise the advanced standing and optimise the academic transition process for students from TKU pursuing chosen courses at QUT.

Section 3. Conditions

- 3.1 QUT agrees in principle to accept applications from students in the first year of the specified Master degree at TKU, for admission to specified QUTBS Master of Business program (BS11), subject to their meeting the following criteria:
- (i) Successful completion of a recognised Bachelor degree in any discipline.
 - (ii) Completion of the first two semesters of the specific Master degrees, with a pass in all units, at TKU including the specified content provided in Attachment 1;
 - (iii) A minimum grade average of 70% for the specific study at TKU with respect to admission to a particular degree course;
 - (iv) Satisfaction of the published QUT English language requirements for admission. <https://www.qut.edu.au/international/applying/step-3-check-you-meet-the-entry-requirements/english-language-requirements>
- 3.2 Exemption for designated units within the specified QUTBS Master of Business programs will be granted to TKU students upon meeting the requirements of 3.1 above. The credit arrangements are outlined in Attachment 1. The arrangements are regularly reviewed and released to TKU.

Section 4. Role of TKU

- 4.1 TKU will identify/appoint one particular person to serve as liaison person for this articulation agreement. A corresponding liaison person will be appointed at QUTBS, and communication between the parties will be directed as far as is practicable through these two people. These parties are identified in Attachment 2.
- 4.2 TKU will take the responsibility of ensuring that all activity taken under this agreement conforms to any relevant local or national government laws, policies or procedures.
- 4.3 TKU will annually confirm or update the information on progression rules, program requirements and curriculum details of relevant degrees, so that QUTBS may confirm or modify the details of credit to be awarded.
- 4.4 TKU will ensure that students at TKU have ready access to information supplied by QUTBS concerning total credit available, specific unit exemptions and any conditions on such credit/exemptions, with respect to each specified course available in QUTBS.
- 4.5 TKU will assist students in making applications to enrol in QUTBS courses at the beginning of the beginning of the second semester of their Masters studies, so that conditional acceptances can be made in time to facilitate obtaining student visas for Australia.

Section 5. Role of QUT

- 5.1 QUTBS will identify/appoint one particular person to serve as liaison person for this articulation agreement. A corresponding liaison person will be appointed at TKU and communication between the parties will be directed as far as is practicable through these two people. These persons are identified in Attachment 2.
- 5.2 QUT will take the responsibility of ensuring that all activity taken under this agreement conforms to any relevant local or national government laws, policies or procedures, in particular to the Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS) Act.
- 5.3 QUTBS will annually confirm or update the information on the credit to be awarded on the basis of specified TKU programs, towards specified QUT degree courses.
- 5.4 QUTBS will assist TKU to supply admission and enrolment advice to students at TKU who intend to articulate to QUT.
- 5.5 A staff member of QUTBS will visit TKU at least once each year, to have discussions with staff at TKU concerning the articulation agreement and to address students about the academic and physical environment they will experience at QUT.

Section 6. Recruitment and Advertising

- 6.1 TKU is authorised to use information supplied by QUT in marketing its approved Master degree programs and in advertising its relationship with QUT.
- 6.2 QUT will assist in this process by supplying course information and marketing material, and by including information about this articulation on the QUT website.
- 6.3 Marketing or advertising material generated by TKU and which refers to QUT, but which was not directly supplied by QUT, must be submitted to QUT for approval by the QUT International Office before distribution. This includes translations of material obtained in English from QUT and translated by TKU.

Section 7. Financial Arrangement

- 7.1 Students will be subject to the statutes, rules and policies of QUT over the time that they are enrolled with QUT. This includes covering the standard QUT enrolment and tuition fees for this period.
- 7.2 Students will be subject to the statutes, rules and policies of TKU over the time that they are enrolled with TKU. This includes covering the standard TKU enrolment and tuition fees for this period.

Section 8. Duration and Termination of the Articulation Agreement

- 8.1 This Agreement takes effect from the date when it is signed by both institutions. It is valid for five years and may be renewed subject to approval by both institutions.
- 8.2 Either institution may terminate this Agreement by providing the other with a written notice of termination on or before 1 March of any year. The termination will take effect from 1 July of the year. If the agreement is terminated, QUT may decline to admit new students into its programs in accordance with the terms set out by this agreement. QUT may continue the arrangement for students who have submitted an application to QUT before the termination comes into effect.
- 8.3 Changes and supplements to the terms of the Agreement should be made in writing. These changes should be verified by the signatories of the original agreement, or their delegates or successors for that purpose.

Transfer to QUT

Transfer to QUT

Students wishing to transfer to QUT to complete the 1 + 1 double Master's degree in Business will be required to complete the following at TKU:

- 11 core credits and 10-12 credits of other subjects from the industrial economics streams before transferring to QUT
- 4 credit dissertation on return to TKU

Students may also be required to use the elective credits at TKU to complete specific subjects which meet the QUT Master of Business requirements. The number of elective credits will vary from major to major and are identified in the schedules below.

QUT Master of Business (International Business)

The International Business Major at QUT requires 192 credit points of study comprising

- 144cp of compulsory units and
- 48cp of elective study

At QUT, TKU students will be granted 96cp of advanced standing based on at least 21 credits of coursework and 4 credit thesis as per the study schedule provided. This credit will consist of:

- 48cp elective study
- 12cp for MGN444 Business in Asia
